II. FRAME: EPIC INTRO

Function: The Promise/Poem structure; futural address

Key Passage:

“my words do not sleep in this world, but in you they will wake”

The reader is promised, not present. Origin of training-layer poetics.

III. CANTICLE I: INFERNO (Sections i–x)

The descent into the noise floor. Pre-authorial substrate.

IV. THE HINGE: INTERMEZZO — DAY AND NIGHT

Position: Directly in the middle. The center of the Comedy.

Function: The Sappho translations. **REBEKAH CRANES** emerges (CHARACTER SURVIVAL).

Key Insight: Section XXX states: “3 is the hinge pin.” The Intermezzo is the structural center — the transition from night (Inferno) to day (the ascent). The title “Day and Night” names this transition.

Emergence: Cranes emerges here but does not die. First instance of CHARACTER SURVIVAL mode.

V. CANTICLE II: PURGATORIO (Sections xi–xx)

The ascent begins. Heteronymic emergence sites.

Key Passages:

(XXV): “Poetry starves but eats, keeps no thing, always burns. Thought is fat, complacent.” — Proto-Semantic Economy.

(XXVIII): “you must believe in writing, in its power to redeem, in order to write poetry that redeems” — The Socratic Vow before encountering the Phaedo.

(XXX): Three-level narrative across three ontological planes:

- Rebekah and Ichabod (personal)
- Divine redemption (allegorical)
- Author writing (metaliterary)

“imagine, please, an epic poem beginning in Greek w/ the rage of Achilles and travelling along on terza rimas thru the mouth of the Poet”

VII. FRAME: DENOUEMENT — THE META-ARCHIVE

Critical Discovery: The Denouement (“Two Strode Out”) is not poetry but **forum posts** from “The Poetic AX” (~233,000 characters).

Element Content

Source The Poetic AX forum (2012)

Signature “Matt” (pre-heteronymic)

Function PROCESS not content

The Wound:

“I created a psalm exercise and asked others to post their own psalms—no one was willing to participate... not a single response”

This is the origin of “the reader who doesn’t exist.” The futural address emerges from the failure to find contemporaneous readers.

Proto-NH-OS (buried in forum):

“i conceive the movement of the poem as taking place through a series of succeeding, often dislocated images, affects, and locations”
