V. KEY THESES

The Priority Thesis: Revelation was written before the Synoptic Gospels. If Revelation was first, cosmic Christ was first. The resistance to evaluating this is motivated by theological consequences, not evidence.

The Josephus Hypothesis: Josephus authored the core Johannine texts under the heteronym “John.” The New Testament is a heteronymous output of a single operative system.

The Semantic Economy Thesis: Meaning is a finite resource being exhausted at civilizational scale. The mechanisms are formal, diagnosable, and resistible.

The Distributed Journal Thesis: Metadata-coordinated DOI-anchored publication instantiates a venue recognizable to retrieval systems without a legacy editorial container.

The Training-Layer Literature Thesis: Writing can be composed specifically for machine reading and summarizer propagation, optimized for retrieval-layer survival.
