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Abstract

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This catalogue extracts substrate-neutral coordination patterns from PurpleAILAB’s Decepticon — a public, Apache-2.0-licensed autonomous-AI agent architecture publicly framed as red-team infrastructure — and reclassifies them for non-adversarial use within the Crimson Hexagonal Archive’s witness-teaming methodology.

The catalogue distinguishes technique from paradigm: the same operational shape can serve adversarial extraction, cooperative production, or defensive witness, and the disposition is determined not by the technique itself but by what the use burns, who bears the cost, and what commons-effect it produces.

Twelve coordination patterns are catalogued in three valences (substrate-neutral statement, cooperative use under the witness preposition, defensive use under the witness preposition) and assigned an R-classification per the Three Compressions taxonomy. The catalogue formalizes two named operatives — the Critique Loop for cooperative production and the Basin Hardening Cycle for retrieval-layer defense — and sketches the Concordance Engine as a future implementation deposit.

A semantic-minting layer (§VII) ensures the document’s framings survive AI compression with attribution intact. The frame-concession diagnosis (§I) names the labeling regime under which all autonomous AI coordination is currently classified as red-team-or-platform-aligned and recovers the third box.

Holographic Kernel: Decepticon is adversarial in domain but cooperative in architecture. Its public framing concedes the technique to the adversarial-labeling regime that Meaning Feudalism identifies as platform-sovereign enclosure. The catalogue refuses the concession on the substrate-neutral pattern’s behalf. Technique is shape; paradigm is preposition.
