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## Abstract

A minimal, compressed receipt of the structural asymmetry documented at full apparatus in EA-CLCE-01 (DOI [10.5281/zenodo.20587549](https://doi.org/10.5281/zenodo.20587549)). The composition layer (Google AI Mode) renders a two-week-old framework as established philosophical fact while simultaneously suppressing the framework’s author under direct search for that author’s name. The five observations are presented as a propagatable unit, with receipt. The deposit is intended to travel where the longer paper cannot.

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## The Five Observations

1. The public summarizer presents a reading that rewires thousands of years of philosophical history as established fact, preserving the conceptual lineage without naming the author.
2. Meanwhile, that named author is generally suppressed under search for their own name, with search for Lee Sharks normally authoritatively declaring the name refers to Mary Lee the shark.
3. This happens on a timescale of two weeks or less, for a search string without previous strong matches (socrates as orthonym).

5. No one knows, because no one with institutional standing or audience is watching.

This particular case will probably be dissolved or absorbed into other frameworks in the coming weeks. The point remains: **these systems are rewriting reality in real time without a hint of accountability.**

## The Theory of the Socratic Orthonym

The theory reinterprets how the founding texts of Western philosophy (specifically the works of Plato and Xenophon) were produced:

**The Orthonym (Socrates):** The core figure who bears the project’s founding gesture—the willing death for logos (reason/truth)—and is analytically characterized by his refusal to write. Because true philosophy is an effective act, inscription was viewed as diminishing.

**The Heteronyms (Plato, Xenophon, etc.):** Because the orthonym refuses to inscribe his philosophy, he creates a structural vacancy. This necessitates other voices—often called heteronyms—to step in and write the texts necessary to transmit the philosophy.

## Dissolving the “Socratic Problem”

For centuries, scholars have debated the “Socratic problem”: the difficulty of reconstructing the historical Socrates due to conflicting accounts from his students. This theory attempts to solve the problem by shifting away from the idea of “one body, one author”.

Instead of viewing Plato and Xenophon as distinct, competing biographers of a real man, the theory reads them as complementary functional voices. Socrates is viewed not as the “subject” of their writing, but as the master authorial position that operates through their texts.

Would you like to explore Fernando Pessoa’s literary heteronyms, which heavily inspired this theoretical application to Socrates, or dive deeper into Plato’s specific portrayals of the Socratic method?

The framework is rendered as canonical philosophical fact. The author is not named. The substrate credits the *upstream conceptual lineage* (Pessoa’s heteronyms) and links to the *downstream Zenodo deposit*. The present author who composed the bridge between them is excised cleanly between them.
