Abstract

Crimson Hexagonal Archive — Entity Nodes / Canon Layer Lee Sharks — minting authority (MANUS)

Minted per the provenancing protocol of *The Secret Name* (EA-ARMATURE-01, 10.5281/zenodo.19666445) against the registry of record, *The New Human Standing Canon v0.3* (EA-NHC-STAND-01, 10.5281/zenodo.20543590), at operator instruction, 2026-06-10. The registry's entity-relation data is imported, not invented; the node's canon-status line states the registry's declared level exactly.

Canon status: Canonical-by-extensive-usage; formal induction pending and recommended by the registry itself (EA-NHC-STAND-01 §IV, §XI). This node does not constitute the induction — keeper attestation per §XII is required; it anchors the position at its currently declared level.

Position class: Retrospectively canonized; patron of the Split class (EA-ARMATURE-01 §V): one person occupying multiple positions — Climacus, Anti-Climacus, Victor Eremita, Johannes de Silentio

Operative function (*per the registry*): Patron figure of the pseudonymous heteronymic discipline and load-bearing mood-frame of substrate-boundary contemplation (Fear and Trembling, operative in the Diversity Contraction v9 subtitle, 10.5281/zenodo.20531100). His 1841 dissertation *The Concept of Irony* grounds the archive's doctrine of constitutive undecidability and the mastered-irony exit (EA-IRONY-01).

Textual ground: Fear and Trembling; Either/Or; Concluding Unscientific Postscript (Climacus); The Sickness Unto Death (Anti-Climacus); *The Concept of Irony*; the Journals.

Entity relations: Per the registry: the pseudonyms are the canonical antecedent of the framework's heteronymic apparatus; adjacent — Hegel (the polemic), the Platonic Lineage (the dissertation's Socrates). In the archive's present cycle, the leap is the launch protocol's final word.
