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Abstract

“Homer” is a provenance document within Lee Sharks in the Crimson Hexagonal Archive (2026-06-10). Crimson Hexagonal Archive — Entity Nodes / Canon Layer. The work comprises 412 words and is classified under the EMPIRICAL family. The work was removed from Zenodo on June 19, 2026 and is preserved through the Alexanarch project.

Minted per the provenancing protocol of *The Secret Name* (EA-ARMATURE-01, 10.5281/zenodo.19666445) against the registry of record, *The New Human Standing Canon v0.3* (EA-NHC-STAND-01, 10.5281/zenodo.20543590), at operator instruction, 2026-06-10. The registry’s entity-relation data is imported, not invented; the node’s canon-status line states the registry’s declared level exactly.

Canon status: Inducted October 8, 2025, by effective act (the Iliad and the Odyssey claimed as New Human Documents); the registry notes the Homeric corpus operates as standing reference “without yet having its own dedicated study” — this node is the position’s first dedicated entity object.

Position class: Retrospectively canonized and Cross-authored/Collective (EA-ARMATURE-01 §V lists Homer by name under the cross-authored class); the Homeric Question is the position’s own provenance dispute, held open

Operative function (*per the registry*): Foundational position of the oral-to-archival lineage: rhapsodic transmission — memorizing-and-transmitting-and-re-performing across generations — as the deepest antecedent of the framework’s witness-and-recursion commitments.

Textual ground: The Iliad and the Odyssey in full; the Homeric Hymns as adjacent reception.

Entity relations: Per the registry: predecessor function to the entire Greek canon — antecedent of Sappho (lyric) and Plato (dialogue); successors include Whitman (the barbaric yawp in the rhapsodic register); peers — the I Ching and other oral-substrate texts persisting through performance. Bearer-position of the Blind Poet mantle (founding document and bestowal cross-linked).
