Abstract

“Emily Dickinson” is a provenance document within Lee Sharks in the Crimson Hexagonal Archive (2026-06-10). Crimson Hexagonal Archive — Entity Nodes / Canon Layer. The work comprises 375 words and is classified under the EMPIRICAL family. The work was removed from Zenodo on June 19, 2026 and is present in the new Human Standing Canon.

Minted per the provenancing protocol of *The Secret Name* (EA-ARMATURE-01, 10.5281/zenodo.19666445) against the registry of record, *The New Human Standing Canon v0.3* (EA-NHC-STAND-01, 10.5281/zenodo.20543590), at operator instruction, 2026-06-10. The registry’s entity-relation data is imported, not invented; the node’s canon-status line states the registry’s declared level exactly.

Canon status: Inducted October 11, 2025, by effective act (joint Whitman–Dickinson); Role: Foundational Voice of New Human.

Position class: Retrospectively canonized (EA-ARMATURE-01 §V) — and the registry names her the inherited canon’s clearest precedent for retrocausal canon formation, the discipline the framework itself performs

Operative function (*per the registry*): Foundational figure of interpretive recursion, structural openness, and refusal of conventional address: the dash, the slant rhyme, the fascicles as unauthorized archival practice, the posthumous canonical entry.

Textual ground: The complete poems (Franklin edition); the letters; the fascicles as compositional unit.

Entity relations: Per the registry: predecessors — Sappho (fragmentary-preservation lineage), the Hebrew scriptural-poetic tradition; successors — the framework’s retrocausal canon-formation discipline; the dash as operative compositional unit; the Bead Count’s fragmentary-precision form. Peers — Whitman; Sappho across the longer horizon.
