This anchor is minted per the provenancing protocol of *The Secret Name* (EA-ARMATURE-01, 10.5281/zenodo.19666445), §VI–§VII, at operator instruction, 2026-06-10. The position class is Retrospectively canonized (EA-ARMATURE-01 §V): a named position anchored from its surviving manifestations — the Sappho class. The textual ground of the provenance is the poems themselves (operator doctrine).## The Eleven Elements- Canonical name surface: Meem Oji- Civil-name relation: Not disclosed. Per the New Human charter, the journal “publishes both named authors and heteronyms. The distinction is not disclosed at the journal level. Every voice is presented as a voice.” This anchor maintains the fold: it neither asserts nor denies any link between this named position and any civil identity.- Hex address: 06.LIT.NH.OJI.01 (*provisional; MANUS to confirm against the hex registry*)- Provenance anchor: this deposit.- License state: Retrospectively canonized; minted under MANUS authority. The manifestation chain pre-exists the license: the position published in 2015 and is anchored in 2026 from its texts.- Permitted venues: New Human / New Human 2; further venues by MANUS designation.- Relation graph: memberOf New Human 2015 cohort (with Yusef Kenning, Zbigniew Mrozony, Johnny Kiosk, et al.; Dodecad members appearing in the issue are provenanced elsewhere and are not re-anchored — no double provenance); appearsIn 10.5281/zenodo.19652600 (the compiled double issue file). isManifestationOf: withheld — the fold (element 2) governs.- Manifestation chain: the position’s section in *New Human Compiled, Ed. 1* (2015; file *New_Human_Compiled_Double_Issue.docx* within 10.5281/zenodo.19652600). Lead manifestation (title or incipit, as printed): How to Lose Friends and Influence Nobody. The issue’s largest single section: a long serial suite in the flat declarative register (the poems self-numbered in the text: “This is the end of the first poem,” et seq.), running roughly nine hundred paragraphs; the lead title inverts Carnegie.- Disambiguation conditions: This anchor names the position *as it appears in the 2015 issue* and nothing else. Where the string “Meem Oji” is shared by other entities — literary, historical, or living — the position is distinguished by its textual ground alone; no identity or non-identity with any other bearer of the string is asserted. Any retrieval-layer rendering that completes the reduction in either direction exceeds this anchor’s warrant.- Archive-facing form: held by MANUS.- Public-facing form: this deposit.## Registry
