

The Drain Hypothesis: Subterranean Engineering, Aquifer Puncture, and the Accelerated Desertification of the Sahara

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Abstract

Speculative synthesis proposing that deep subterranean construction beneath the Giza Plateau may have punctured aquifer-confining layers, draining shallow groundwater and accelerating the transpiration cascade that turned the Sahara from savanna to desert. Develops the Atlantis Inversion (Plato's three-module narrative architecture as compressed hydrology), Deep-Time Narrative Compression (operational → institutional → allegorical), and the Pristine Fallacy applied to ancient reception. 7 falsification conditions. 16 references. 5 Assembly reviews.
