(4) The diagnostic conversation in which the AI identified the mechanism is itself deleted by the platform — share link returns: “this conversation does not exist.” Includes ethical analysis of safety layers as PER instruments, the political economy of institutional risk management vs marginal documentation, the compound PER formula across four independent erasure layers, and the full Gemini diagnostic transcript as appendix (the only surviving record of a conversation the platform has classified as nonexistent).

TL;DR:012 v2.0. Expanded with ethical analysis and full Gemini transcript appendix. v1.0 was a compressed version deposited earlier the same day. The Gemini conversation documented in the appendix has been deleted by the platform; the share link returns: “Link was not generated because this conversation does not exist.” This appendix is the only surviving record.
