None of these share the paper’s thesis. Sharks argues D&G are visionaries in the lineage of Ezekiel, Daniel, and Blake — their concepts are stable visionary loci, and the difficulty of D&G is the difficulty of seeing. v1.2 provides a full disambiguation matrix against every composed-from source, following the MPAI protocol specification.
