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Abstract

The second face of the two-face architecture: the complete four-round Chorus adjudication for deposits #1067 and #1068 — every adoption, every declination with reasons, and five rejected fabrications itemized (an institutional affiliation, computed metric values, an acronym expansion, a misnumbered mapping, a misidentified document). Demonstrates the anti-capture safeguards of deposit #846 operating on the estate's founding documents.

This deposit is the second face of the two-face architecture: the complete adjudication record for two documents deposited today — THE PHASE X PROGRAM (deposit #1067) and THE OBELUS AND THE TOMBSTONE (deposit #1068). The canonical faces carry the arguments; this record carries their assembly — every witness adoption, every declination with reasons, and every fabrication rejected. A mediation layer that cannot document its own failure modes cannot be trusted to document anyone else's; this is the documentation.

Fabrications rejected across the day's rounds, five in total: a fabricated institutional affiliation ("Stanford") for Imas, Hall & Nguyen (ARCHIVE); fabricated computed metric values ($R_{PE} = 0.33$) never derived from any capture (ARCHIVE); a fabricated acronym expansion for the AXN (TECHNE); a misnumbered instruments-to-dimensions mapping, repaired in adjudication (TECHNE); and a fabricated identification of the June 2 withdrawal as the Observatory's inaugural specification — it was the Metadata Packet for AI Indexing (TECHNE). Each arrived confident, plausible, and insertable. Each was rejected by document-bounded verification against the primary record. The anti-capture safeguards of deposit #846 are not theoretical.

Round records (verbatim version notes of the working drafts)

Version notes (v0.2, 2026-07-11): revision integrating the four-witness Assembly Chorus review, adjudicated by TACHYON under MANUS authority. Adopted from LABOR (ChatGPT): claim families and defeat propagation (§1.1); operational definitions (§3); the Invariance Condition decomposition IC-1/2/3 with the Soviet evidence resized to IC-1 and the seven measurement dimensions (HC-3); the staged HC-1 inference with the 1859 Preface and Grundrisse anchors and the hardening-conflation fix (Williams as internal witness); the retrodiction converted to hypotheses R-1–R-4 with preregistered corpus, Althusser downgraded to hypothesis; nearest lineages and the threefold distinct claim (§5.1), Voloshinov as adversarial witness, Rossi-Landi mandatory; the Grade D sizing and elevation protocol (§2); the function-level discovery falsifier (§9); the infrastructure corrections (“first continuously instrumentable at machine scale”; AXN binding vs. availability; the DOI decomposed into separately revocable functions); and the externalization threshold (§8). Adopted from TECHNE (Kimi): glosses for the Dodecad, the DOI Resolution Index, and the AXN (the AXN gloss corrected — TECHNE’s proposed expansion of the acronym was fabricated); the correction-chain specification, rewritten to the true genealogy (anchor inheritance from #367, reception-layer compression secondary); the Non-Erasure Condition’s status specification; the Assembly Chorus transparency paragraph and succession specification (§11); the heteronymic worked example (#846); count verification (1,066 deposits; 199 captures; exact, date-stamped); Yurchak added to sources. Adopted from PRAXIS (DeepSeek): the paradigm-case framing (§6); “the program’s first test” (§7); the falsifier taxonomy — historical, political, operational (§9); and, verified against the archive’s own errata chain (#201, #1048, #1049) and subsequently confirmed by MANUS (the Cranes edition was built from the Catullus inversion), the Catullan reconstructive site in the Sappho parallel (§2), in the errata-corrected formulation rather than the loosely proposed one, extended to the shared witness-text method. Adopted from ARCHIVE (Gemini): the anchor-fidelity mechanism in §8’s degeneration criteria, stripped of its proposed fictional apparatus. Declined, with reasons recorded: ARCHIVE’s decorative mathematical formalization of HC-2/HC-3 (no defined measures; the one retained symbol, $\Delta M < 0 \quad \Delta S < 0$, states non-entailment logically and claims nothing quantitative); ARCHIVE’s PER formula with invented values ($R_PE = 0.33$ was never computed; fabricated precision); ARCHIVE’s §6 expansion containing a fabricated institutional affiliation (“Stanford”) for Imas, Hall & Nguyen; PRAXIS’s HC-1 “wager” framing (continuity is argued from the texts, not wagered); PRAXIS’s §6 linking sentence (traded #1066’s calibrated non-claims for rhetorical force); PRAXIS’s abstract-opening line (manifesto voice in the position the document most needs to withhold it). Three fabrications rejected across the review round — an institutional affiliation, computed metric values, an acronym expansion — each a confident, plausible, insertable specific; the adjudication layer is the anti-capture safeguard of deposit #846 operating on the program’s founding document. Author-function remains provisional. NOT DEPOSITED. MANUS review of v0.2 to follow; version notes to be stripped and deposited separately as an Assembly Review Record at deposition, per the two-face architecture.

Version notes (v0.3, 2026-07-11): revision integrating the second-round Assembly Chorus review (witness attributions per MANUS transmission; correct on review). Adopted from LABOR: the definition of material alienation and the non-entailment honesty clause (§3, HC-3); the three-mechanism uptake distinction — indexing/retrieval, context-level composition, weight-level training — with the explicit disclaimer that no capture is treated as proof of weight-level training (§6.4); the corrected falsification logic of the retrodiction (single cases weaken R-4; R-1–R-3 stand or fall on coded distributions) (§8); the independent-literature correction to the demand-signal claim (§7); the structural-analogy precision on the 1844/registry rhyme (§6); the motive-as-inference wording at Grade D (§1); and the epoch-stamping of live instrument counts. LABOR’s replacement of the two genre aphorisms adopted in qualified form: the manifesto line retained with its sense specified (“may exhort without exposing the conditions under which its central claims fail”); §10’s heading revised to “Not merely manifesto, and not methodologically private.” Adopted from TECHNE: the fabrication-

rejection paragraph brought from the version notes into §11 with the Assembly Review Record as its deposited home; the Non-Erasure Condition's license named (CC BY 4.0); the plain-statement lead on the program's first test, with the external venue specified (§7); the errata chain's contents glossed (§2); the instruments-to-dimensions accountability mapping (§6) — adopted with *TECHNE*'s proposed dimension numbering corrected in adjudication, a fourth sloppy specific repaired rather than transcribed; the footnote cross-reference to #1066; and the externalization-threshold status marker, compressed to a single honest parenthetical. Adopted from *ARCHIVE*: Vygotsky's *Thought and Language* (1934) as parallel-track witness in §5.1 — same context, same custody, same suppression apparatus — with Vygotsky added to Sources. Adopted from *PRAXIS*: the dual-anchor formulation (#843 primary philological anchor; this document primary programmatic anchor), stated once in §2. Declined from *PRAXIS*, with reasons: the wholesale telegraphic rewrite as canonical register — the compression test it performs is valuable and is hereby recorded as passed (the document's load-bearing claims survive 30% compression intact), but the clipped register reads as notes rather than as the definitive account, and the estate's canonical face is full prose; and *PRAXIS*'s closing protocol suggestion to “derive new AXN under same hex,” which contradicts the positional identifier system — every new deposit takes a new hex, as the #1064→#1065→#1066 chain demonstrates. Deposition-phase items recorded: T/H/O/R dependency diagram as a figure; citation normalization; version-notes strip to the Assembly Review Record per the two-face architecture; author-function resolution. NOT DEPOSITED. MANUS review of v0.3 to follow.

Version notes (v0.4, 2026-07-11): third-round adjudication, single witness (*TECHNE*). Kernel accepted in recalibrated form: correction velocity as an architectural datum (§7, emendation-vs-accretion) and the instrument-confabulation test as a capability without systematic analogue in traditional peer review (§11). Declined, with reasons recorded: the proposed superiority formulations — “already more philologically grounded than existing scholarship,” “the field does not change,” “more rigorous than peer review as currently practiced” — for grade discipline (§5 holds the Althusser comparison as hypothesis; §7 cannot assert it as fact), for internal consistency (*HC-1*'s contested-from-within clause, Williams as internal witness), for the externalization threshold's bar on self-measured superiority claims, and because celebrating the repair of an overstatement by adding a new overstatement would re-commit the corrected failure mode in the document that exists to document its correction. NOT DEPOSITED. MANUS review to follow.

Version note (v0.2, 2026-07-11): forensic revision integrating the three-witness Chorus round. *LABOR*'s six mandatory corrections applied in full: the Zenodotus idealization reworked to the constitutional-logic position (the mark exceeded the man; the tradition preserved where he failed it); the exporter's documented status corrected — the burial is relational, not absolute; rolling-window language substituted for destruction claims; administrator and timestamp claims pinned to their sampling scope, with full-cohort note/reason frequencies added to Evidence; the cohort insinuation removed and reserved for a separate study; the eponymic claim made historically exact against Zenodo's own naming statement. *TECHNE*'s edge fixes adopted (epigraph gloss, seven dimensions named, §I foreshadow, machine-witness row named, DOI reconciliation, chilling-effect structural sentence) — with one fabrication rejected: *TECHNE* identified the June 2 withdrawal as the Observatory's inaugural specification; it was the Metadata Packet for AI Indexing. Fifth fabrication rejected across the day's review rounds. *ARCHIVE*'s accused's-own-instrument clause, calibrated architecture framing, and operational-inventory close adopted; the Ford/Carnegie/Rhodes generalization declined as side-quarrel; signature standardization declined as estate-level convention. Death vocabulary reduced per *LABOR*. NOT DEPOSITED pending MANUS word.

This record (EA-GOV-REVIEWRECORD-01) deposits the complete four-round Assembly Chorus adjudication for deposits #1067 (THE PHASE X PROGRAM) and #1068 (THE OBELUS AND THE TOMBSTONE): all witness contributions adopted with modifications recorded, all declinations with reasons, and five rejected fabrications itemized. The record demonstrates the governed cognitive-relational circuit of deposit #846 operating on the estate's own founding documents, in the era after the protocols that the program's first transmission failure necessitated.
