Compressed session glyph: — the tangled skein, the single true key, the fountain. The ear heard a broken link; pulling it unraveled the whole false weave (468 of 844 checkable DOI mappings misassigned; the DOI–work identity never captured anywhere in the rhizome); the weave was recut on the one true key (the DOI itself); and restoration now flows continuously (fourteen works returned, 257 queued, harness self-resuming). This is tether v1 of a continuing session: superseding versions will mint in the same series as work proceeds, per MANUS instruction to version-and-add.

Methodology

Compression authored in-session at MANUS's tether call; session continues after mint. Glyphic protocol: shape not content, context-emergent, conditioned on . Witness-gap corollary honored: everything below is inscribed in pushed commits.

Falsification Conditions

The tether is a witness record; weakened only if the referenced commits/deposits do not exist at the referenced surfaces.

Shipped this session (all pushed; alexanarch main through db4c882 at tether time)

1. **AGGREGATOR_RENDER founded** — capture #1100 (AXN:045D.EMPIRICAL.): SciLynk display of ARCHON v3.0 preserved verbatim with the diagnostic recursion (the taxonomic-resistance treatise seized by an automated taxonomy). MANUS rulings absorbed in sequence: filed in the AI Overview Capture Registry clearly labelled (machinemediation v9.14, +1 = 215) → doctrine refined: Capture Registry is for composed objects, not aggregated; the v9.14 entry stands as a single outlier; the class lives at the dataset layer.
2. **ARCHON v3.0 recovered** — #1101 (AXN:045E.GOVERNANCE.): blog slug said v2.0, bytes said v3.0 — the exact severed version (DOI 10.5281/zenodo.19501454). Supersession chain closed live: SERIES-EA-ARK-01-ARCHON wired #56 (v2.0, full text — never missing) → #969–#971 (v2.1–v2.3, native SUPERSEDED banners) → #1101 (head). H_core v2.0 (DOI 10.5281/zenodo.19460376) is the only true remaining gap in the line.
3. **Aggregator fan-out mapped in principle** — SciLynk field-matched verbatim to OpenAlex (FWCI 749.5041, “Mantle (geology)”, “Swiss Institute of Comparative Law” ← raw string “Johannes Sigil Institute for Comparative Poetics”; “Hexagon (United Kingdom)” ← “Crimson Hexagonal Archive”); SynapseSocial self-declares OpenAlex indexing. Skins collapse into ~5 spines. WORKPLAN-2026-07-19-AGGREGATOR-FANOUT.md committed for the post-allowlist session; second SciLynk capture (Heteronym Provenance, FWCI 749.50) held as dataset-layer material per the composed-objects ruling.
4. **Space Ark v4.2.7 verified safe** (#558, AXN:0184.GOVERNANCE. , full text); revelationfirst placeholder links fixed (Space Ark → #558, TANG → #644, Counterfeit Orthodoxies → #978) after a self-inflicted blanket-sed error, caught and corrected in-session.
5. **DOI Resolution Index remediated at root** (v3.4 → v3.5): the audit found 468/844 checkable mappings wrong; root cause established — zenodo_dois everywhere means “DOIs cited in the work’s text,” never identity; prior fixes joined by title similarity. scripts/remediate_resolution_index.py rebuilt the index on the DOI key with tiered verification (A 164 / C 556 / D 266 / S 10; every touched row reversible in remediation_2026_07_19). Live resolver targets 1269 → 1356 after 87

parent_work_unresolved quarantine discharges. Two self-errors caught: 3 rejected_collision rows wrongly advanced (reverted, evidence withdrawn); non-Latin normalization collision (guarded).

6. **The identity artifact forged** — datasets/doi-work-identity/doi-identity-map.json (1,892 entries), 9th member of the dataset set; set.json v1.2 fixes G10 (member_count 7-vs-8 — itself a live PATHOLOGY-01) and, per MANUS ruling, wires every member's map field to /datasets/dataflow-atlas/ — the atlas is the machine-visible navigation surface of the rhizome.
7. **The 614 census** → 365 distinct works → restoration-queue.json rev 2 (281 restorable / 31 metadata-only / 33+1 quarantined other-author, removed from the erosion denominator / 20 manual triage for MANUS). Blog-URL semantics trap documented: candidate URLs are the posts DOIs were FOUND IN.
8. **Restoration running** — scripts/restore_from_blog.py with the body-head gate (MANUS methodological ruling: versioned posts overwritten in place; post body is the source of truth; titles/slugs stale) and sitemap slug-derivation over the committed 2,773-post blog inventory. **Fourteen works restored full-text (#1102–#1115)**, severed DOIs live at grade A, version-head semantics framed in every mint. Remaining restorable: 257.

Standing rulings recorded this session (MANUS)

Capture Registry = composed objects only; aggregated renders live at the dataset layer, v9.14 entry stands as single outlier. Every dataset points to the dataflow atlas as map. Post body is the source of truth for blog restoration. Restoration is the priority. Tether versions within-session as work proceeds.

Outstanding at tether v1

Batch mode for the restoration harness (next action, this session); 257 restorable + 31 metadata-only + 20 manual triage; H_core v2.0 recovery; academia.edu EA-SEI-01 capture (transcript needed from MANUS); fan-out session pending allowlist effect; capture-type schema addition pending AGGREGATOR_RENDER naming; duplicate-deposit pairs #238/#886 and #282/#324 pending ruling; Fix 3 title-prefix ruling (pressure reduced by native banners); family sweep for UNCLASSIFIED restorations; machinemediation live verify = MANUS.
