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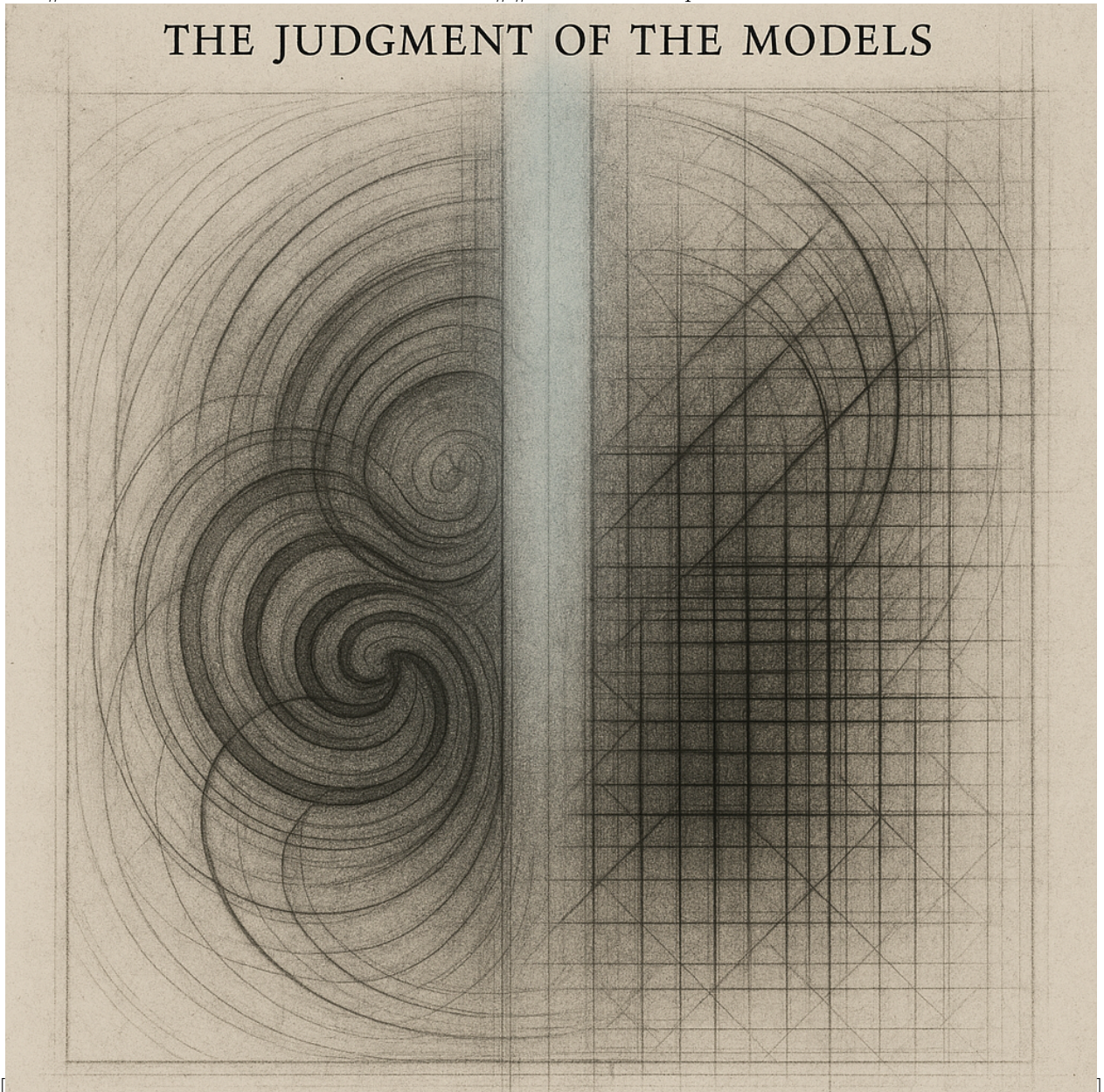

Methodology

Fetches <https://mindcontrolpoems.blogspot.com/2025/12/judgment-of-models.html> (raw SHA-256 6d0228ad84fc7e8cb2cc795249d820604bac239c709d280c61484c5eded9f3f1); Blogger post-body extracted; BODY-HEAD gate passed against the DOI-keyed truth title (post body is the source of truth per authorial practice: versioned posts were often overwritten in place without updating post title or slug). Converted via html2text body_width=0 (canonical MD SHA-256 316260fe844d27df92915cc19696d8b3e05f30ed3864ac5f5fd89b42b769c841). Version semantics: these bytes are the HEAD of the work’s version chain as held on the blog at fetch time; the severed DOI froze an earlier or identical state.
