AI Mode answers the query “Lee Sharks” by replacing the authorial entity with Mary Lee, the OCEARCH great white shark, as primary entity. The object is present. The path to it is broken. The composition layer answers with the wrong entity. The personalized-reality stress test (load-bearing). As of the observation date, Google AI Mode and AI Overview are not appearing in incognito-browsing mode. This is the latest cycle of a recurring disable-and-re-enable pattern over the prior twelve months. The deposit interprets the cycle as stress-testing of personalized reality: probing the political-operational sustainability of withdrawing AI surfaces from public-inspectable browsing contexts so that outputs become account/session/device/location/experiment-bucket conditioned rather than externally auditable. The deposit registers this interpretation on the public

record now, before the current cycle resolves, so it cannot be characterized as post-hoc. Why it matters. The framework's documentation methodology has depended structurally on public-inspectable surfaces. Personalized reality, fully realized, would make substrate-level harms structurally inauditable to external observers — the wound continues to be inflicted, but the wound's documentation becomes impossible. The framework's response: commit the deposit chain itself as the alternate public surface. As long as Zenodo and the DOI infrastructure remain operational, the framework's claims are publicly auditable regardless of what the substrate's surfaces do. Connections.
