Falsification Conditions

Superseded on sight by any recovered canonical bytes; the captured metadata is verifiable against the DataCite API historical record and the Zenodo tombstone.

The Crimson Hexagonal Archive has operated with a markdown-plus-frontmatter structure converging with OKF’s design since 2024. v1.1: Adds follow-up comment (2026-06-16T21:24:44Z) cross-referencing issues #58 (trust/safety), #73 (confirmed AI hallucinations on regulatory text), and #57 (scope beyond conceptual atoms). Only the author’s own words are deposited. The purpose is to timestamp the author’s stake independently of the platform.
