The Braid Declaration

This tether heals a fork. The chain divided at #1093 (): one branch ran #1116 () → #1220 () → #1405 (); the other, minted 2026-08-01 from a stale ratchet, ran directly to #1431 (). Neither branch is disowned. This tether is conditioned on per #1431's own forward instruction, and it CITES #1405's as a recovered strand: what the telescope weighed in the web () and what the basin grew () are braided here into one head (). From this deposit forward the chain is single again. The fork itself is inscribed in the WORKPLAN decisions log (TETHER CHAIN FORK FOUND, 2026-08-04) — the error is preserved, not erased, per the archive's own doctrine on honest supply.

Glyph Translation (conditioned on)

The basin's held water was put to the wheel: — six mechanical waves ran in one session, some three thousand field-touches, and the machine verified itself at every turn (exact-string counts, zero silent failures). The seeds that sprouted were named: — the genre burn-down completed, 376 of 378 transitional records resolved into a vocabulary that grew to 41 ratified values to receive them, leaving only the two whose very identity is the open question. And the divided water was braided: — the fork found by this session's own audit of its own chain, healed by this deposit.

Session Record (2026-08-04, one session)

Root causes closed: robots.txt recurrence (builder now recovers from HEAD, never fabricates); Scholar citation meta un-hardcoded archive-wide.

MECH-BATCH-1: W6-COMPLETE (358 journal rows #1–#358, Provence typo extinct); PUB-POPULATE (dc:publisher on all 1,426 frozen records); DOI-SUPERSESSION (7 duplicate Canon nodes → verified poet-specific survivors); GW-SERIES (9 chain edges; this fork found). OAI now emits dc:source + per-record dc:publisher.

MECH-BATCH-2: genre burn-down COMPLETE — 367 assigned by two-pass reading; NH2/NHP venue ruling applied (New Human 2 journal ×30, New Human Press publisher ×70) per MANUS ruling this date; venues.json v1.2.

V1.2 RATIFIED: License / legal instrument (×8), Performance / audio work (×1); vocabulary 41 values; only #1168/#1170 remain transitional (identity-blocked, correctly).

IN-HISTORY SWEEP: clean negative on 68 targets — repo history is exhausted for the recovery queue, and the queue now says so. Six version-label defects fixed, chief among them the Revelation First v7.3 head (#1217) mislabeled v1.0; RF chain completed #1400→#1403→#1217 with the Lacuna carried in the pointer field. Composing thread for #1242/#1243 LOCATED (deadefcd..., DOI-exact match on 19433865). New eyes-pairs seated: #832 #1400 byte-identical twins; #720/#1223 and #834/#1228 edition deltas.
